

MAPLE TREE SCHOOL SUPPLY THANK YOU!

Wowzers! Thank you to everyone who donated to our 17th annual Maple Tree Elementary school supply drive. This was our most generous year yet and brought the staff to tears. We collected over 2259 items valued at over \$1600 including 735 pencils, 130 boxes of crayons, 212 glue sticks, 111 notebooks, 63 boxes of markers, 14 water bottles, over 1000 stickers, 18 boxes of Kleenex and 29 backpacks. Simply amazing! The 230+ children and staff at Maple Tree are always so grateful to the members of West Granville for their continued support over the years.



We are also pleased to share that a Donor Advised Gift of \$20,000 has been given to the Forward Scholars Tutoring Program at Maple Tree School. With the budget crunch at Milwaukee Public Schools, the program is undergoing financial reorganization and hopes to be up and running soon.


